Review of Business Plan 2023-2024

The Executive Board (March 2023) reviewed the Business Plan 2022-2023 and agreed the proposed Business Plan Priorities for 2023-2024.

Discussion was informed evidence of the impact of the work during the year drawn from:

- Rapid Reviews Four rapid reviews were completed for children living in Derby and Derbyshire
- Child Safeguarding Practice Reviews Three reviews were completed and published during the year. Two reviews are in different stages of completion.
- QA Performance Reporting Key performance information over the year, relevant to the issues below, has been used, alongside information and analysis from different subgroups, as appropriate
- Multi-agency Audit One audit was completed focusing on domestic abuse and the impact on children
- Strategic developments such as the evaluation arrangements for Keeping Babies Safe and impact on practice in Derby and Derbyshire
- Evidence from external inspection
